Responsibilities include or have included producing Quality Assurance Project Plans for all water quality monitoring projects and special studies; conducting field audits to oversee local partner monitoring activities; facilitating bi-monthly meetings of local partner agencies to plan monitoring strategies and disperse information; administering special studies such as the Bacteria Die-off Study, the Mustang Bayou Systematic Monitoring project, the Clear Creek Illicit Connection Source Identification and Elimination Project, and the Dickinson Bayou Pre-TMDL Study for Dissolved Oxygen and Bacteria; conducting inspections of municipal and industrial wastewater treatment facilities; managing a local water quality monitoring program for the County of Galveston and employee training and development.

In addition to earning a BS in Fisheries & Wildlife Biology from Iowa State University, Ms. Wright has completed many hours of specialized training over the years. Training includes, but is not limited to, the TCEQ and predecessor agencies: Surface Water Quality Monitoring Field Methods and Quality Assurance, EPA's Quality Systems training, Texas Watch Trainer Certification, and Texas Watch Quality Assurance Officer Certification. Plus, the Texas Engineering Extension Services complete wastewater series of courses for plant operators, collection systems, and laboratories.
