Carol A. Ellinger, P.E. is a Senior Assistant Director within the Planning and Development Services Division of the City of Houston's Department of Public Works and Engineering.

Ms. Ellinger is responsible for the development of the City of Houston's annual Capital Improvement Plan which includes planning, prioritization, and funding for infrastructure projects citywide. She also leads the City's stormwater efforts for compliance with NPDES permit requirements and stormwater quality management, serves as one of the City's representatives to the HGAC stakeholders group for total maximum daily load (TMDL) planning and studies, and serves as a City representative for the Bacteria Implementation Group (BIG) to work with HGAC to prepare an implementation plan for the TMDL Program.

Ms. Ellinger has 16 years of engineering experience in the areas of watershed planning, floodplain studies and mapping, regional project implementation, and stakeholder engagement. Her experience includes both design at a private consulting firm and program management at the Harris County Flood Control District prior to joining the City of Houston.
