Brief statement of background and qualifications:

Glenda Callaway has undergraduate and graduate degrees in political science with a second field of economics from the University of Houston. Her interest in freshwater inflows dates to her graduate studies and participation as part of a multidisciplinary team assembled for a multi-year National Science Foundation project to address environmental planning in Chambers County, Texas. She assisted with the formation of the Galveston Bay Freshwater Inflows Group, and has been a member of the support team for that group for the past decade.

She is the Principal of Ekistics Corporation, a consulting firm that specializes in environmental policy and public involvement projects related to infrastructure planning and development. Her projects range from assisting the Harris County Flood Control District in its response to Tropical Storm Allison and subsequent flood events, to serving on the consulting team assisting the Region H Water Planning Group to plan for long-range water supply.

She is an emeritus trustee and past chair of the Galveston Bay Foundation, having actively assisted with the Foundation's formation. She also currently serves as a member and past chair of the Galveston Bay Council, an advisory body to the Galveston Bay Estuary Program of the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality. She serves on the Natural Resources Advisory Committee to the Houston-Galveston Area Council, and is an Advisory Board Member of the Bayou Preservation Association.

She was recently appointed to the Basin and Bay Area Stakeholder Committee that was established by the State Legislature to address environmental flows for the Trinity-San Jacinto and Galveston Bay watershed.
